

2. *When were women in NH allowed to vote?*

Answer: Trick question—all of the above. In 1784 women officially lost the right to vote in NH by state law. In the 1890s NH was one of eight states that allowed women to vote for school officials (probably what we now would call school boards). But it was not until 1920 that women were granted the right to vote in all elections on the same basis as men.
