#1. League of Women Voters NH invites all members, spouses and potential members to come to **Day at the Legislature on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 beginning at 9:00 a.m.**

We'll spend the morning visiting the state house, sitting in on committee hearings and getting a little tour. Then, we'll have lunch at the Common Man restaurant in Concord, sharing what we have learned. Following lunch a few board members and a guest speaker will update us on what is happening legislatively and strategically with some of our priority issues, including the new women's prison, county corrections, the death penalty, election law, and expanded gambling.

When and where: Tuesday, April 5. 9:00 a.m. at the League office, then walk across the street to the state house and LOB. Later, drive to the Common Man for lunch, socializing, and sharing of information.

Tim is a Senior Lecturer in Sport History, Media Relations, and Sport Industry at UNH. He previously taught at Umass-Amherst and at Iowa State. Tim was a print and broadcast journalist and radio and television sports broadcaster in Massachusetts and Virginia before turning to teaching and has been active in media relations and new media since coming to New Hampshire.

Celinda Lake is a leading political strategist. She has worked for a number of institutions including the League of Women Voters, the Democratic National Committee (DNC), the Democratic Governor's Association (DGA), AFL-CIO, SEIU, CWA, IAFF, Sierra Club, NARAL, Human Rights Campaign, Planned Parenthood, The Next Generation, EMILY's List, VoteVets Action Fund, and the Kaiser Family Foundation. She is the founder of Lake Research Partners, which has become one of the most respected Democratic polling firms in the country. Celinda is one of the nation's foremost experts on electing women candidates and on framing issues to women voters. Prior to forming Lake Research Partners, Celinda was partner and vice president at Greenberg-Lake.

Jill also worked in the U.S. Senate for Senators Paul S. Sarbanes (MD) and George J. Mitchell (ME).
